

Oxford Go Tournament: Sat 16th Feb 2013

Date: Saturday 16th February 2013

Format: Main tournament: 3 rounds McMahon. 50 minutes main time; Canadian byōyomi (30/5).
Novice tournament: as per main, plus (optional) extra self-pairing games.

Timings: Registration: 9.00–9.45am. 1st round 10am. Prize-giving 5.45–6.00pm. Supper 6.30pm

Fees (includes tea/coffee and biscuits):

BGA members: Standard: £7 Concessions (students, under 18s, pensioners, unwaged): £5

Non BGA(/other national Go association) members: £10 (£8 concessions)

Late entry surcharge (after Tues Feb 12th 2013): £3
